JOURNAL ENTRY

Bedford Municipal Court is hereby amending the Local Rules of the Bedford Municipal Court as follows:

Rule 27.00 Civil Case Management

A. All contested civil cases, except forcible entry and detainer, replevin and small claims, shall be set for either a pre-trial or oral hearing with the Judge assigned to the case.

Further, In accordance with Ohio Rules of Superintendence 36.011(B)(1), Court will assign a judge randomly on all civil cases when an answer is filed or when a motion is filed after the complaint, with the following exceptions:

- NOTICE OF DISMISSAL (prior to assignment)
- SATISFACTION
- NOTICE OF BANKRUPTCY and/or DISCHARGE
- MOTION FOR DEFAULT JUDGMENT
- AGREED/CONSENT ENTRY (prior to assignment)
- REQUESTS FOR SERVICE

All other sections of Rule 27.00 remain in full force and effect.
